

THE ELLA FRENCH SCHOLARSHIP

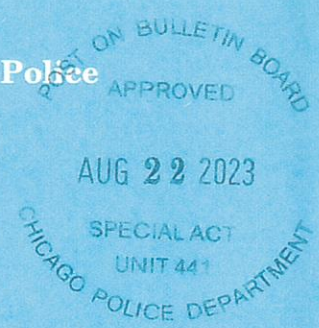


The Ella French Scholarship is awarded to children of the Chicago Police Department and other youth actively involved in police programming to provide financial assistance to offset high school expenses such as tuition, supplies, and transportation. The Scholarship will be awarded at the True Blue Gala in November. Multiple scholarships may be awarded up to \$10,000 and the Ella French Scholarship Committee will determine the final award amount.

THE DEADLINE HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO 01 SEPTEMBER 2023.

Applicants must be anywhere between an incoming freshman in high school to an incoming freshman in college of July 1, 2023, show proof of attending or about to attend high school, have a 2.7 (or higher) GPA, and have good attendance. To be eligible for the Ella French Scholarships, applicants must also fit ONE of the following criteria:

- A child of a currently active or former (retired) Chicago Police Officer or employee of the Chicago Police Department
- A child of a fallen Chicago Police Officer
- A high school student who is an active participant in a Chicago Police Department youth program, including:
 - Youth District Advisory Council
 - Chicago Police and Firefighter Training Academy
 - Police Explorers
 - Police Athletic and Arts League
 - Police Cadet Program
